

Items for Realtors Renting at Kure Beach

Ordinances you should be aware of that carry fines and are STRICTLY ENFORCED:

- Keep off the sand dunes at all times. Use designated beach accesses only. (\$100)
- Pets (\$150 for each violation)
 - Are **NOT** allowed on the beach from **April 1st - September 30th**.
 - All pets must be on a leash at **ALL** times.
 - You must **pick up and dispose** of pet waste.
(There is a dog park within the city limits of Kure Beach)
- **No Littering (including cigarette butts)**. Trash cans are available at all public entrances. (\$25)
- **Nothing** can be left on the beach from **7 p.m.-8 a.m.** Violations will be removed daily and fines will follow. (\$50/\$100)
- **Turtle nests** cannot be disturbed and are clearly marked on the beach. (\$1,000)
- **No fires or grills** are allowed on the beach strand. (\$100/\$200)
- **Alcohol** is prohibited. (\$25)
- **NC State fireworks laws are in effect at all times** in Kure Beach.
- **Vehicles** are prohibited at **all** times on the beach strand. (\$25)
- **Fill in** all sand holes before leaving the beach. (\$100)

Lifeguard Information:

- Lifeguards are on duty from 10 am to 5 pm daily from Memorial Day thru Labor Day weekend.
- Flags flown on the lifeguard chairs are:
 - Green** –calm conditions.
 - Yellow**- Use caution (possible rip currents)
 - Red**-Use EXTREME CAUTION (High Rip Currents)
 - Black**- NO lifeguard on duty
- Look for designated areas marked for Rip Currents by lifeguards.
- Read signs posted on the beach that describe a Rip Current and how to escape from one. (**75%** of all water rescues are results of Rip Currents)
- Handicap accessible beach ramps are located on E Ave., L Ave and Atlantic Ave.
