WHEREAS, the N.C. coastal region contributes significantly to the economic well-being of this State; and

WHEREAS, the Cape Fear Region of Brunswick, New Hanover, and Pender Counties ("Region") have experienced high increases in coastal homeowners insurance costs threatening the Region's economic recovery; and


WHEREAS, the increases threaten the economic well-being of every customer in this Region, not just those on the barrier islands; and

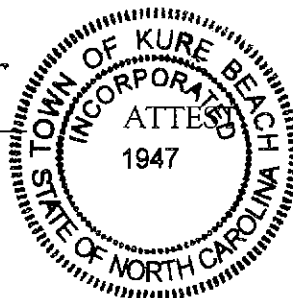
WHEREAS, the NC General Assembly during the 2009 Session can lay the ground work for reforming the insurance rate process and improving the North Carolina coastal insurance costs; and

WHEREAS, the Cape Fear Coalition of Concerned Citizens (CFC3) has been established to represent a broad array of private/public entities and individuals who share concerns over issues such as insurance rate/system reform, affecting the Cape Fear Region's future and desires to raise awareness and serve as a collective advocate on those issues.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Kure Beach supports the CFC3's efforts to help achieve a fair and equitable settlement of current and future coastal insurance rates and procedures.
