WHEREAS, the North Carolina coastal region contributes significantly to the economic well-being of this State; and


WHEREAS, the Cape Fear Region of Brunswick, New Hanover and Pender Counties ("Region") has experienced high increases in coastal homeowners insurance costs threatening the Region's economic recovery; and

WHEREAS, the increases threaten the economic well-being of every customer in this Region, not just those on the barrier islands; and

WHEREAS, the North Carolina General Assembly during the 2009 Session can lay the groundwork for reforming the insurance rate process and improving the North Carolina coastal insurance costs.


